# Greetings:

Jesus Christ is risen! He is risen indeed. Alleluia!

At this time of year (perhaps unsurprisingly) I quite often find myself distracted by busyness. Advent and Christmas have flowed quickly into Lent and Easter and then ANZAC Day arrives. I quite often find myself at the end of April wondering where January went. At times like this I find great solace in Daily Office; an obedient rhythm of contemplation and reflection that restores my soul. The simplicity and repetition of it is what I enjoy most ... I just have to turn up and engage in it ... and leave space to be drawn into the grace and comfort of prayer.

And then we look at our lectionary and we see themes of great joy, of new beginnings, of growth and abundance; it can all seem so tiring ... why can't we just slow down and get ready for winter? Our readings this week and next create images of Christ as the vine/ vineyard ... with references, implicit and explicit, to pruning and training, and harvest, and productivity and abundance ... and expectation ... or else!

Don't be afraid. There's joy in there too. Thorough knowledge, careful pruning, detailed planning might lead initially to lower volumes ... but what eventually grows on the vines is of better quality as a consequence, and is therefore suitable for development into great wine. The process requires great discernment (read God's grace) along

with plenty of sun and rest that eventually produces the best fruit. Wonderful stuff ... but produce fruit we must.
