Liturgy: p.476 Te Pouhere Sunday Psalm 67

Greetings:

Today is *Te Pouhere Sunday* ... a birthday of another sort.

Today is the day we celebrate the *three stranded* nature of our Constitution (the original was signed on 13 June 1857 but was significantly updated in November 1990). It now recognises each of the cultural voices in our church as "equals" and gives each an *equal* say in how we develop and express our identity from solid ground within one family of faith. While I have some personal issues about the word *equal* in this context (as we are not equally resourced) I completely agree with the principle. My own preference would be that we shared/contributed *equitably*, based on the principle in Acts 2, but that's just me.

On another matter, I have had some questions this week about the ministry into the Port that I mentioned last Sunday. Just to be clear, I do not envisage any change to the current cycle of Sunday or Wednesday services, nor to the current frequency/timing of services at Matua, or at Bob Owens. What it does mean though is that I will be in the office less during the week and may have less availability for emergent needs within a short response time.

There will be a period of adjustment as we move forward, but you can be assured that I will still be here each week and will be available on the phone, even if you have to leave a message for me to call back.
